

For the first time, the Fair was co-hosted with our girls' school.

SPORTS AND CULTURE

ARCHERY

CHESS

Averaj Goel representing Mayo College won a gold medal and the Most Promising Chess Player Award in the Shri B M Khaitan Memorial Chess Championship.



GYMNASTICS

The Mayo College U-19 Gymnastics Team won a team gold in the District Championship. Three boys were selected for the State Gymnastics Championship.





SWIMMING

The Mayo College Swimming Team bagged 2 gold medals in the 4x100 relay and 11 gold medals in the individual category at the Under 14, 17, and 19 District Swimming Meet. Eight boys were selected for the State Meet.



YOGA

The Mayo College Yoga Team won four gold medals in the School District Yogasana Competition and three gold medals in the Ajmer District Yogasana Competition. Five boys were selected for the State Championship.

SHOOTING

The Mayo College Shooting Team won a record of sixty two medals in all competitions this year. Eleven boys qualified for the Nationals. Bhavamanyu Singh Shekhawat and Karan Raj Singh qualified for the Indian Team trials.



TABLE TENNIS

The Mayo College Table Tennis Team won gold medals in the under-14 and under-17 team events. Five boys were selected for the State Table Tennis Championship.




