




EDITORIAL NOTE




"bulldozer committee" FINANCE TRACK

Last Year Review

The inaugural edition of the Mayo Model G20 Summit, themed "Let There Be Light छ वसुधैव कुटुंबकम्," was a colossal that brought together event the brightest from prestigious minds institutions across the nation to address urgent political, social, and economic issues while mastering collaborative diplomacy, innovation, and sustainable solutions. This prestigious event brought together nearly 150 delegates from renowned institutions 20 nationwide. Over three days, participants deliberated continuously in four working groups: Migration, Global Counter-Terrorism, South and Environment Inclusion and Climate Sustainability, as well as in the Finance Track and the Sherpas Track. high-level discussions. Their negotiations and problem-solving exercises *mirrored* the actual G₂₀ summit and culminated in the creation of the 25-page Mayo Declaration. The

event was further distinguished by a keynote speech from Mr Amitabh Kant, former CEO of NITI Aayog and India's G20 Sherpa. *It was a firstof-its-kind event*, offering a fully accurate simulation of the actual G20 Summit in the country with an *idiosyncratic* format uniquely formulated *without any reference*.
