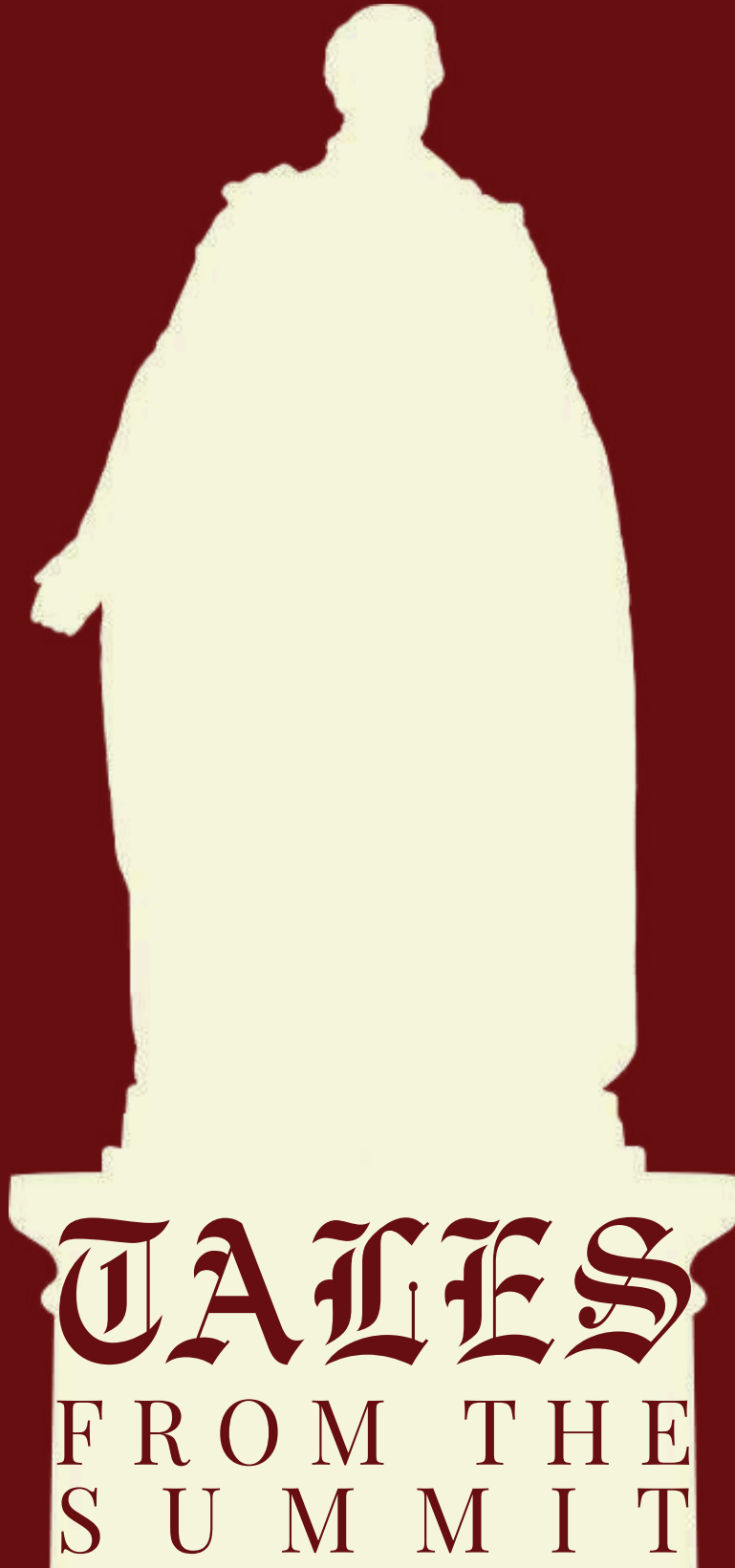

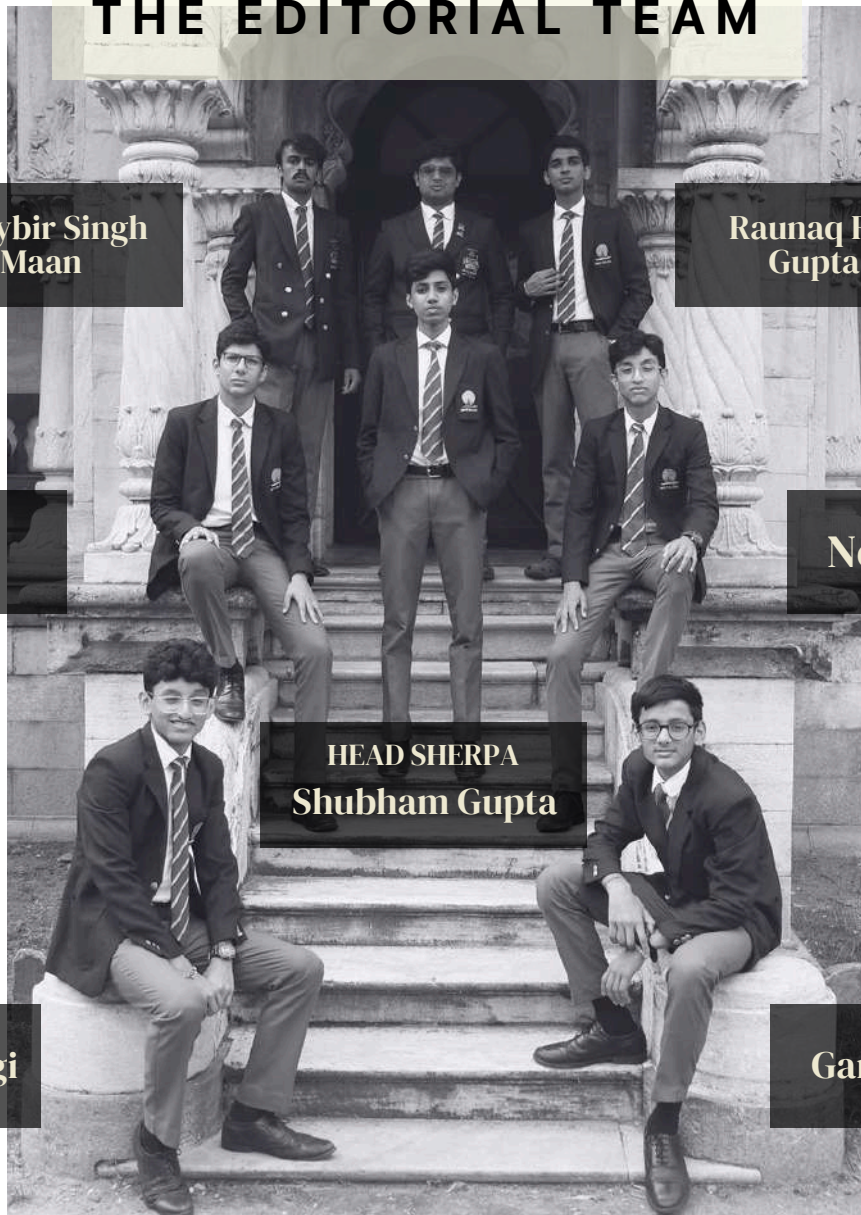

"kuch mila nahi"

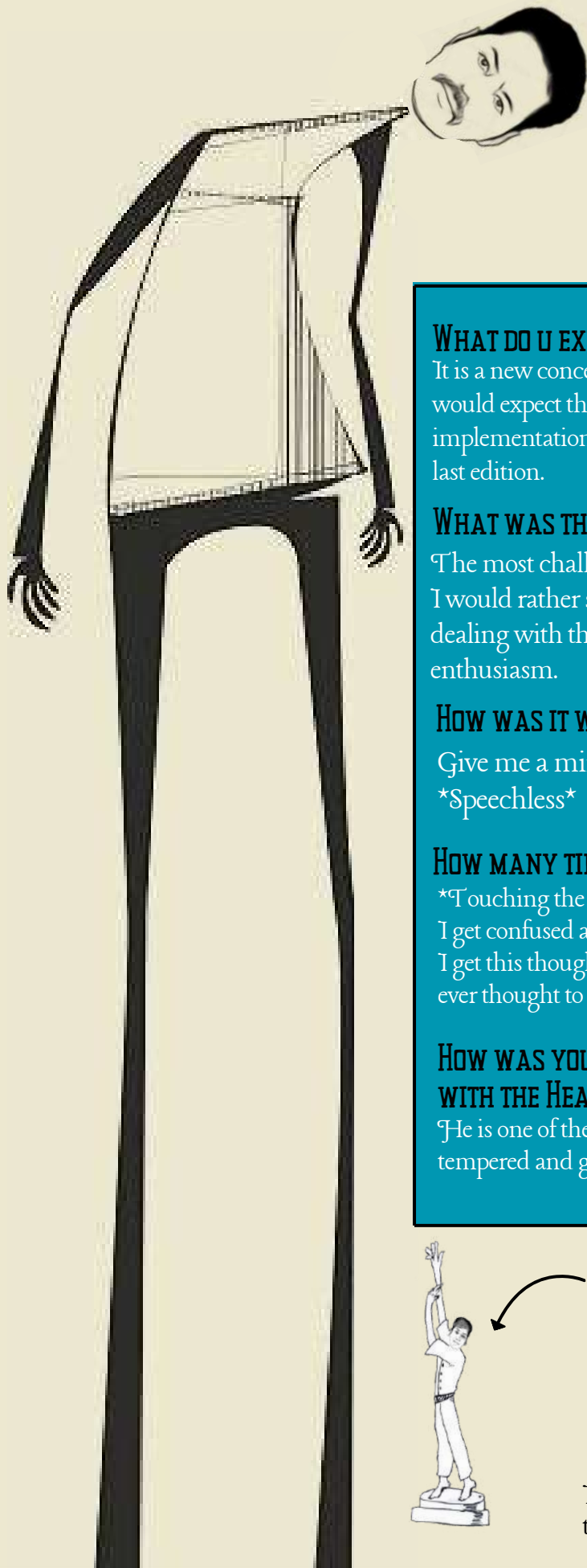

G20 Inaugural Edition

Last Year Review



The inaugural edition of the Mayo Model G20 Summit, themed "*Let There Be Light* ॐ वसुधैव कुटुंबकम्," was a colossal event that brought together the brightest minds from prestigious institutions across the nation to address urgent *political, social, and economic issues* while mastering collaborative diplomacy, innovation, and sustainable solutions. This prestigious event brought together nearly 150 delegates from 20 renowned institutions nationwide. Over three days, participants deliberated continuously in four working groups: *Migration, Counter-Terrorism, Global South Inclusion and Environment and Climate Sustainability*, as well as in the Finance Track and the Sherpas Track. Their high-level discussions, negotiations and problem-solving exercises *mirrored* the actual G20 summit and culminated in the creation of the 25-page Mayo Declaration. The

event was further distinguished by a keynote speech from Mr Amitabh Kant, former CEO of NITI Aayog and India's G20 Sherpa. *It was a first-of-its-kind event*, offering a fully accurate simulation of the actual G20 Summit in the country with an *idiosyncratic* format uniquely formulated *without any reference*.

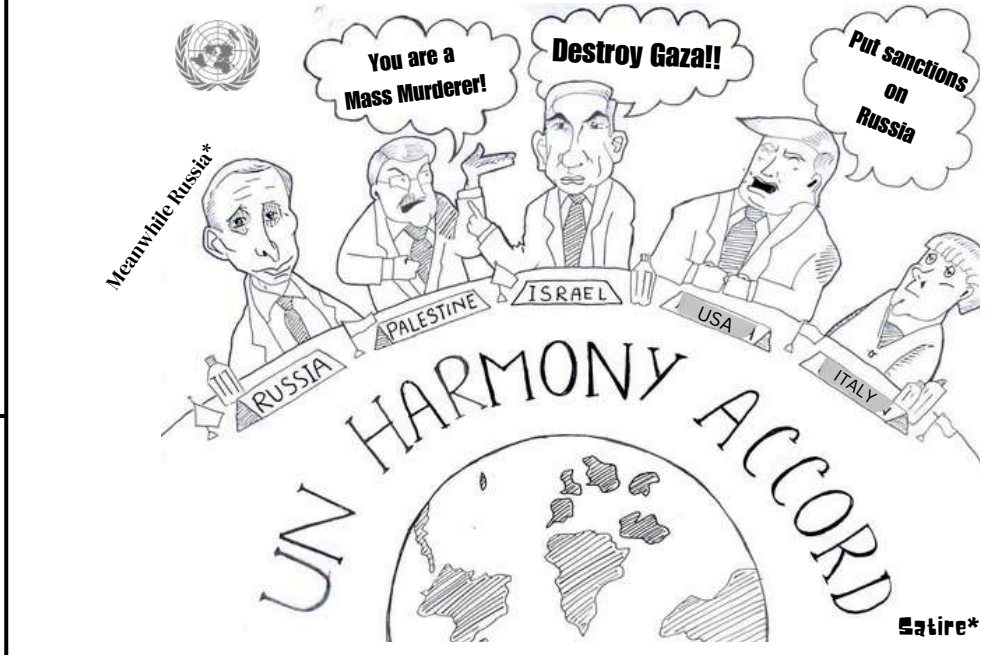
