WELCOME MR SAURAV SINHA



Anna's recount of 16th-17th September 1978

Today is 16th of Sept 2023. Exactly 45 years back Mr. Shah, Gilbert Bose and I were planning to climb Madar Pahad to have a view of the Full Moon eclipse, starting at 10pm at night and getting over by 2am on 17th that was Sunday.

It was 16th of Sept, 1978. It was a Saturday. After having dinner in the middle house mess, we started from Kashmir House, I was then the House Master. For Madar, we climbed through the gorge to reach the top. Exactly at 10pm the Earth's shadow started covering the moon. At 12am it was a total eclipse. Down the hill, Mayo tower with it's Big Ben, streets with dim streetlights could be seen. Delhi bound train running at full speed, throwing head light and whistling, curved past Madar. As it passed Madar, we saw compartments asleep in a dim light. It was a sight to remember. We sat down for a while chatting, for the moon to come out, which happened at 2am. There was more surprise to follow. As we came down and started walking back along the foot of the hill, around 3.15am, suddenly, the ground around us was illuminated. We were taken aback. Naturally we looked up. I will express in Italian language as " streno ma Vero ", meaning, "strange but true ".----U.F.O. !! Could not believe our eyes. But it was true It was a U.F.O.

We saw it for five minutes. No noise and absolutely still. There was a gap between two saucer like things and a brilliant light was emanating.
